So, what's God saying here? God's saying here, okay guys, everything belongs to me but I'm giving you dominion. I'm giving you an assignment. I'm giving you the ability to be creative, to become doctors and nurses and lawyers and pastors and parents and be in relationships and build airplanes and build houses, to create music, to create art. God gave you dominion. The owner of everything is giving you a license to do what: Be creative. To work with the wonderful abilities He's given you; to have great things done in your life. However, as you do that, you have to remember and never forget for whom you work. Never forget who's in charge and who gave you that license to have dominion.

Now, you may be asking how am I supposed to have dominion? What am I supposed to do? What does that mean for me? And do I have the talent and the skill, actually, to do something in this world? Now if you're asking that, you have to remember that it takes faith. To have dominion, means you have to have faith. Faith in God.

So, how do we learn this kind of faith? We learn that kind of faith in a little parable that Jesus taught us. It's found in Matthew 25, and Jesus is speaking: "For the kingdom of heaven is like a man traveling to a far country who called his servants and delivered his goods to them. And to one he gave five talents, to another he gave two, and another one, one each according to his own ability. And immediately, he went on a journey. The one who had received five talents went out and traded with them and made five more. And likewise, he who gained two talents also gained two more. But he who had one, dug a hole in the ground, and hid the lord's money."

In this parable it's very clear that there's one master, the master of the house. To us that's God. He's in control of everything. And He's going away for a little while and what's He to do? He hands out assignments. He trusts His servants to do something with it. We're made for a reason.

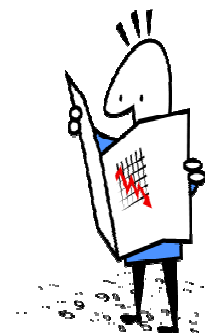

If you are interested in volunteering for any the positions or would like to nominate another member, the duties of each of the Officer position is provided below:

**GRAND KNIGHT:** The Grand Knight (GK) is the chief administrative and financial officer of the council. He presides over all council meetings and is Chairman of the Board of Trustees. He appoints a Program Director, usually the Deputy Grand Knight. The GK works closely with the Deputy Grand Knight and the Activity Directors, to plan, coordinate, and conduct all council activities. The GK is an ex-officio member of all committees.

**DEPUTY GRAND KNIGHT:** The Deputy Grand Knight (DGK) performs all the duties of the GK in his absence or the inability of the GK to perform his duties. The DGK is usually appointed by the GK to be the Program Director. The Program Director is responsible for working with the Activity Directors to plan, coordinate, and conduct all council activities.

**CHANCELLOR:** The Chancellor assists the GK and DGK in performing their duties. He is the third in line of succession to be elected to the GK position. He works with the Program Directors to encourage membership participation in the council activities. He exercises special interest to the sick or distressed members.

**RECORDER:** The Recorder keeps a true record of all the doings of the council. He is responsible for the minutes of all monthly council meetings and others as determined by the GK.

**TREASURER:** The Treasurer is the custodian of all council funds. He receives from the Financial Secretary, all monies. He deposits all monies, and disburses all monies of the council after proper approval has been obtained from the appropriate officers.

**ADVOCATE:** The Advocate is the attorney of the council in case of the trial and investigation of any matter of interest to the council. He keeps current on the Supreme and council by-laws, and the Roberts Rules of Order

**WARDEN:** The Warden is in charge of all council property, except money and account/record books. With the assistance of the guards, he arranges the council chamber for all meetings and degree ceremonies. He verifies the membership of all members at meetings and conducts balloting as directed.

**INSIDE GUARD:** The Inside Guard attends the entrance to the council chamber from the inside door. He assists the Warden in the performance of his duties.

**OUTSIDE GUARD:** The Outside Guard attends the entrance to the council chamber from the outside entrance. He also assists the Warden in the performance of his duties.

**TRUSTEES:** There are three Trustees who serve under the GK. They supervise the financial business of the council, approve payments, and audit the accounts of the Financial Secretary and Treasurer every six months. They serve three, one year terms. One trustee is elected each year.

**FINANCIAL SECRETARY:** The Financial Secretary (FS) is appointed by the GK and Trustees and is approved by the Supreme Knight. He receives all monies owed the council, collects dues, and maintains the council membership roster. He also advises the Retention Committee, GK, and Trustees when a member becomes delinquent in paying his dues. He is the official contact with the Supreme office.

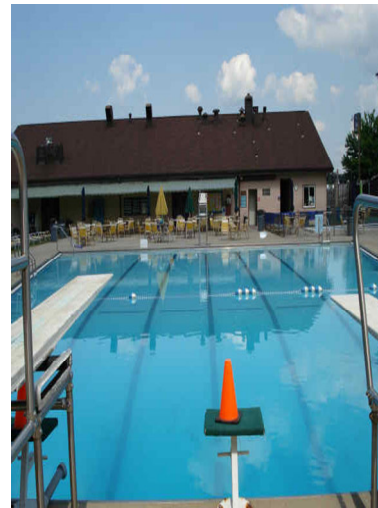
